Foreword:

The two main planets that we look at in a Forecast Chart Reading (also called a Transit Reading) are Jupiter & Saturn since they stay in one part (house) of your chart for a year (Jupiter) or two (Saturn) and therefore are suitable for some major planning purposes.

The first five planets – Sun, Moon, Mercury, Venus, and Mars – are called personal planets and move rather quickly through each part of your chart, from a couple of days in each house (section of your chart) to a few weeks. They relate more to short-term or daily life activities. When Venus or Mars stays in one part of your chart for an extended period, which can happen sometimes, information will be included in your reading. Extended visits from Mercury are covered in the last part of your reading.

The last three planets – Uranus, Neptune & Pluto – are called generational or outer planets and take a number of years to go through each part of your chart. We don't look at them in-depth like we do Saturn & Jupiter but do list some general characteristics of their transits in your chart.

The same thing that applies to the personal planets also applies to the main asteroids. Except for Chiron, which has about a two-year transit in each sign like Saturn does, the other main asteroids (Ceres, Pallas, Juno, and Vesta) usually occupy each part of your chart for a shorter period of time. When any of them stays in one part of your chart for an extended period, information will be included in your reading.

All information for the possibilities in your future should be read with the phrase “the likelihood is that” in mind. Interpretations should be understood as potentials only and not predictions. Additionally, it would be impossible for astrology to predict anyone's actions, including other people who might be connected to your situations.

The purpose of this reading is to give you the mostly likely challenges and opportunities, what areas of your life they will impact, and the timeframes that are involved.

How to Use your Forecast Reading

This reading is a guideline that shows, according to your chart, what is likely to happen. It is presented in categories (Jupiter/opportunities, Saturn/challenges, etc.) and then each category is further defined by timeframes.

It is suggested that you read the document all the way through to get a general feeling about your Forecast year. Then you may want to break it down into sections and focus on one block of information at a time.

For example, you could look at the Jupiter category first – here is where you will usually find the nice things or opportunities listed. Then you could look at the Saturn category – which is where you will usually find the challenges listed for the year of your reading; however, sometimes it also has some nice things. When Jupiter or Saturn changes signs within the year of your reading, that timeframe and the possibilities are also listed within the related categories.

Then you could read the sub-categories such as Venus, Mars, and the asteroids. These listings have specific dates attached to them and may not apply for the entire year of your reading.

The three outer planets (Uranus, Neptune, Pluto) have energy that is going through your chart but is more in the background. Of course you can dip into anything listed with these planets and bring that to the forefront if you'd like.

If you are curious about a particular timeframe, you can read selections from each category that pertain to that time. Items listed in each time period will not occur for the entire period; some will appear earlier and others may show up later. If you are curious about a certain area of your life, you can go through the reading and highlight each item (and note the timeframe) that pertains to that area.

If you are interested in Mercury retrograde or any of the eclipses, you could mark these times on your calendar and then read, about a week ahead of time, how they could impact your chart.

As you read through the information, keep in mind that when things show up they are often not as good or as bad as one thinks they will be. If there is an area of your life or a timeframe of interest that is not addressed in your reading, it means that things will likely remain the same or that your chart is open for whatever you would like to do re: that subject or time.

Remember that you are in charge of your life. If you don't want to be involved in any of the potential items that are listed anywhere in your reading, you can choose not to be.

Jupiter transit in your chart

This planet usually represents pleasant happenings or nice opportunities that will likely show up for you. Some keywords are growth, expansion, generosity, and optimism. One thing to remember is that sometimes the effects of a Jupiter transit don't show up until late in the designated timeframe.

(If a chart has a later degree number connected to the sign on the cusp of each house [0-30 degrees in each sign], two houses are listed in a Forecast Reading for this planet because technically Jupiter is moving through one house and into the other. The second house number* listed has the greater emphasis, but the first is included for information that may still be quite applicable.)

Jupiter in your 6th/7th house until mid-July 2014:

6th house - On one hand, Jupiter in this location is really good for health. Any health concerns you have or medical situations that occur will likely be easily resolved and turn out just fine. On the other hand, weight gain could happen, so be advised. If you so wish, this is a very good time to expand or improve your work conditions. You may want to update your personal environment and review your nutrition program.

*7th house - This is very good for your marriage or for a business partnership. Benefits come from associations with others. There is the potential for strong harmony in your marriage. It will likely be easy to reach out and bring your loved one closer. Take a vacation together if you can. Do all kinds of things that will produce growth and increased commitment.

Jupiter in your 7th/8th house for the remaining time of your reading:

7th house - This is very good for your marriage or for a business partnership. Benefits come from associations with others. There is the potential for strong harmony in your marriage. It will likely be easy to reach out and bring your loved one closer. Take a vacation together if you can. Do all kinds of things that will produce growth and increased commitment. (As you can see, there is a bit of an overlap here with the previous notation & date; however, it's such a nice overlap that you probably will be delighted.)

*8th house - If possible, avoid taking on excessive debt as things could get out of hand in that area. On the up side, this is an excellent time to explore ways to alleviate any debts. There is the potential for financial assistance from resources other than your own. Joint finances are nicely highlighted. A possible inheritance or an increased sex life could show up with this Jupiter position.

Transiting **Jupiter aspects** (connections to your birth planets) until mid-July 2014

opposite natal Mercury – speak, write, make contacts and presentations. Don't get discouraged if some of these things don't work out right away. Other people may not immediately appreciate your forward thinking and ingenuity.

trine natal Mars – sometimes your energy level will feel really high. Conserve yourself though and don't overextend in any way. You may feel so good that you feel like you can do just about anything, which is a nice feeling but probably not feasible. This is a nice aspect for health, except for the potential of weight gain.

You have the ideas & energy to make sure that things run smoothly and get completed as easily as possible. This is a good time to start a project or to get something underway that you have been thinking about. Look for opportunities to move ahead in an area of your life.

sextile natal Pluto – this is likely a good time to address situations or circumstances that used to be classified as overwhelmingly filled with power or control issues. Pluto will help keep matters at a bottom-line basis without an excess of barely related items clouding any resolution. And Jupiter will bring lots of optimism and open-minded perspectives to the table.

Transiting **Jupiter aspects** for the remaining time of your reading

opposite natal Sun – most aspects of Jupiter to one's Sun sign or Mars indicate the potential for weight gain. This particular aspect, on the other hand, indicates the potential to reshape your weight if that is a concern. The Jupiter/Sun aspect involves the 1st house in your chart, so that makes it very personal. Therefore, this is also a good time to get any or all of the areas in your life that are out of sync, back in balance.

conjunct natal Moon – lots of optimism and good feelings in general will offset any challenges that come up.

opposite natal Venus – if you are single, love could just fall into your lap. Make sure this is something you really want. If you are in a love partnership, this is an excellent time for special romantic dates. This is also a good time to access your creativity or bring some balance to a business partnership.

square natal Jupiter – avoid jumping to conclusions. Unrealistic thinking may be present. Don't believe all that you are told or all that you hear. Mental focus may be slightly unclear so it's best to check things carefully.

Increased mental activity; you have a lot to say either in verbal or written form. Make notes about all of your ideas because they will be coming too fast and furious to act on at the time. Then choose what you want to present to other people or what you want to explore for yourself.

square natal Saturn – sometimes it might feel like things are moving sideways instead of forward (or even backward). This slowdown is present because it's time to review one or more things and to make some changes or alterations in the direction they are headed. Timing is important, as well as professional ethics. Some things just can't be rushed and shouldn't be compromised.

sextile natal Uranus – this is definitely the time to step outside of the box and just go for it, no matter what "it" is. Your unique approach to something will really pay off. Some unusual and exciting adventures could come your way. Sudden opportunities could burst onto the scene.

You may find that your intuition has expanded significantly. At times you may feel like limitations in your life will never be resolved; however, changes may occur out of the blue so have faith and do something fun to release any restless energy hanging around.

trine natal Neptune – your spirituality, imagination, and creativity are enhanced. Sometimes it might feel like you are operating from another plane of existence. Mystical drifting and dreaming will feel like second nature. The only down side to this aspect is to be extra careful about being taken advantage of. It might be a chore to embrace reality sometimes, but it also might be very important.

Saturn transit in your chart

This planet usually represents challenges that will likely show up for you, although sometimes it also represents potential opportunities.

(If a chart has a later degree number connected to the sign on the cusp of each house [0-30 degrees in each sign], two houses are listed in a Forecast Reading for this planet because technically Saturn is moving through one house and into the other. The second house number* listed has the greater emphasis, but the first is included for information that may still be quite applicable.)

Saturn in your 10th/11th house for the entire timeframe of your reading:

10th house - Take a strong and forceful stance in your career/job. It's time to redefine and restructure something in that area of your life. This is the big 'do over' time in your job situation. Increased responsibility will lead to increased achievement. Hard work will be necessary and will also be rewarded.

It is likely that you will accomplish what you set out to do and that you just might receive recognition from professionals as well as the general public. If you are considering retiring from the general work force (this might be unlikely), this is the right time to establish a business of your own or to really dig into one or more of your hobbies.

*11th house - Review your long-term goals and see which ones still meet your desires and needs. This also applies to your friends and acquaintances. Do any of them drain your energy, get on your nerves, or take up your valuable time unnecessarily? It may be time to move on. If you are in any formal or informal groups, are they still what you are looking for or do you feel like you have gained all you can? Direct your loyalty toward grounded, useful circumstances that are focused on the greater good for humanity.

Transiting **Saturn aspects** for the entire timeframe of your reading

trine natal Mars – physical activity is highlighted. This is a good transit for your health, so take care of anything that requires attention, especially if it involves teeth or bones or eyes. Also, relationships with male members of your family or some of your male friends will help you out a lot. Be sure to ask for assistance if you need it because it will be given readily.

sextile natal Pluto – introspection and contemplation are favored. You may be drawn to study the mysteries of life in a serious way. You will recognize and appreciate the depth of your strength and wisdom as you go through any major changes. You may want to keep some of your plans for change a secret, for now at least.

Venus and Mars

(These two planets are delineated only if there is an extended transit period.)

Venus – 1st house until early March 2014

This transit focuses on beauty items, including wardrobe, cosmetics, hairstyle, perfume, and jewelry. Treat yourself to something new in at least one of these categories. You may want to treat a special female in your life with something from one of these categories too.

conjunct natal Mercury – interactions with others are prominent. Some very good advice or information comes your way.

Mars – 10th house until late July 2014

A significant amount of energy may be required for something related to your career or position in the community. Or, you may find that is where your attention is drawn and that you have lots of ideas to put into action there.

conjunct natal Uranus – an almost overwhelming desire for independence and a great sense of restlessness could result in impulsive or rash actions. This aspect also shows the potential for increased business or professional activity. Friends or organized groups will possibly contribute to your well-being. Honor any new and unusual ideas that come into your head during this time.

Outer planet transits

Uranus – 4th house

Some kind of upheaval in the home or re: your real estate. You may change residences or purchase more property. Or there is a situation (or two or three) between you and your family members; this might be combative or confrontational. You could bring someone into your home who is rather different from everyone else. Or you could redo your home into a unique and unusual style that might grate on other people's nerves but suits you quite well.

Neptune – 3rd house

Your imagination and spirituality will be obvious in your speaking and writing. Sometimes it will seem like you say things from your gut-level intuition and wonder if you actually have the facts to back them up. Don't worry, there will be an element of truth in whatever you say and you can easily refer people to resources for more information. What you have to say will be an inspiration to others.

The down side of this Neptune transit is that vagueness and confusion may permeate communications. Do a reality check before making any decisions or commitments.

Pluto – 1st house

This house is a very personal part of your chart and it in some way reflects all the rest of your chart. Pluto in this location means that your whole life is undergoing some major changes; pretty much every area of your life is being transformed and regenerated. Some of the changes may be subtle and you may not notice them until later or unless you pause for reflection.

Progressed natal Sun –

Your birth sun sign is Aquarius and will remain Aquarius for this lifetime. However, as you go through life years, one or more other signs, depending on the numerical degrees involved, will add to the flavor of your Aquarius. This is called a progressed sun sign.

Your Aquarius sun in your birth chart is at 3 degrees (there are 30 degrees in each sign), which means that when you were 27 years old, you were ready to progress or add another sign to your Aquarius, which is Pisces. At that time, some Pisces traits were added to your being for the next 30 years.

In 2014, you will still have a Pisces progressed sun and it will be in place for another 13 years (until about age 57, which is when your progressed sun will move into Aries). As you move through each progressed sign, a few traits from the previous ones will probably remain intact. By the way, your Pisces progressed sun sign is at 17 degrees in 2014. This is called the spirituality degree, which means that you will in some way have an interest in the spiritual side of life.

Here are some descriptors for Aquarius, Pisces, and Aries:

Aquarius (birth sun sign) – this sign is interested in humanity, enjoys being outside of the mainstream, being involved in change, and charting new directions. You undoubtedly have a natural knack for the unusual, the odd or unexpected, the offbeat and non-mainstream.

If you maintain a dry wit, a sort of Monty Python sense of humor, this will get you out of sticky situations should they arise. Some keywords for this sign are: independent, innovative, intuitive, progressive, eccentric, utopian, and creative.

Pisces (starting at about age 27) – pay a lot attention to your dreams and intuition. Music, photography, poetry, and watercolors are suggested art forms. Sometimes you will feel like you have no energy at all. Be sure to honor these times and get some extra rest. Meditation and visualization are suggested.

Your receptive and perceptive nature gives you the ability to see through the subtle layers of human existence. Go with your gut-level feeling when in doubt about anything, meaning those flashes of intuition that unexpectedly come your way; this will also easily get you out of any difficult situation.

Some keywords for Pisces are empathetic, compassionate, sensitive, ethereal, mystical, intuitive, and introspective.

Aries (starting at about age 57) – leadership, ideas, and physical activity are highlighted. Delegate projects and follow-through to others; your job is to generate the ideas because you have a natural knack for coming up with ideas and initiating action. You are likely quick and to the point and may easily become impatient when others do not grasp things as speedily as you do. You can effortlessly debate or argue your way out of any sticky situation.

Some keywords for Aries are eager, impulsive, direct, quick, courageous, active, spontaneous, daring, and pioneering.

And by the way, your birth sun is in the 1st house of your birth chart, which indicates that Aries qualities have always been present in your traits. So this progressed sun will probably feel very natural to you.

As you may already know, the Sun travels through each sign in about 30 days and the Moon travels through each sign in about 2 ½ days. Mercury usually stays in each sign for around 3 weeks except for the 3 or 4 times a year when it slows down for a couple of weeks and takes longer to go through a sign. Venus usually stays in one sign for a little longer than Mercury or the Sun do. Mars has about an 8-week visit in each sign, except for about every two years when it slows down and spends around 8 months in a sign.

The location of each of these personal planets, along with that of Jupiter & Saturn, the three outer planets, and the main asteroids, is listed each week on the Moonscopes website www.moonscopes.com so that you can track where they are by sign and then can insert them into your chart if you'd like.

Here is the sign on the cusp (beginning edge) of each house in your chart so that you can use any of the resources listed at the end of your reading to do your own interpretation of the planets as they pass through the houses.

1st – Capricorn

2nd – Aquarius

3rd – Pisces

4th – Aries

5th – Taurus

6th – Gemini

7th – Cancer

8th – Leo

9th – Virgo

10th – Libra

11th – Scorpio

12th – Sagittarius

Chiron transit in your chart

Chiron, 3rd house

This asteroid/planetoid is strongly suggesting that communication, education, social activities, and travel be integral in your life at this time.

Chiron usually stays in one part of your chart for about a little over two years, very similar to Saturn's travels. However this time it is making an extended stay, until late April 2018, in one sign/area of your chart so you have plenty of time to explore ideas and ponder actions.

Asteroid transits

Ceres, 10th house until Aug. 8, 2014

This asteroid is in charge of self-care, as well as nurturing and support for others. You could be asked to teach or train someone in your workplace. Or, you could take someone under your wing, so to speak, in community affairs.

Pallas, 9th house until Aug. 12, 2014

This asteroid is connected to skills & resources. A road trip may clear your mind and set the stage for your next round of ideas. You may think of a way to market your experience or a way to pick up any new skills you need. A cultural encounter could be beneficial. In other words, 'get out of Dodge' for a while and let your mind wander.

Juno, 8th house - Oct. 8, 2014 – July 1, 2015

This is often called the partnership or marriage asteroid. Its location in your 8th house puts an emphasis on joint finances. It also indicates that an inheritance could come to you or your spouse, money or possessions.

Vesta, 10th house until July 31, 2014

This is usually referred to as the asteroid that rules passion, devotion, and service. When it is traveling through the part of your chart that is associated with career and place in the community, it strongly suggests that it's time to review what you are doing and make sure it is something that you feel dedicated to.

Mercury Retrograde

Here is a list of the Mercury retrograde periods for the year timeframe of your reading. It will show where each retrograde period will occur in your chart.

Feb. 6 - 28, 2014 – 2nd house

Finances and possessions are the focus. Track your money carefully. Double-check any bills you receive and any payments you make. It would be best to make purchases (except for essentials) after this retrograde period has concluded.

June 7 - July 1, 2014 – 6th house

Health matters are highlighted. Review your nutrition regimen and explore what might be added, changed, or updated.

Oct. 4 - 25, 2014 – 10th house

Review your place in the community. Something about your reputation from the past could crop up. This is also a good time to take stock of your career, but don't make any major changes until this retrograde period has ended.

A reminder:

When Mercury is retrograde, the speed of the planet slows down considerably. Communications, paperwork, and traffic can become very mixed-up or delayed during this time. Also, electronics can develop problems. You may want to back up your computer files. Remember to double-check all plans and arrangements. A situation very well could be in the process of changing, so wait until Mercury is direct to finalize anything. This includes major sales or purchases as well as significant agreements.

Also, wherever retrograde Mercury is currently located in your astrology chart is where you may experience a return to the past in some way, such as reconnecting with a person or situation represented by that particular part of your chart. Wait until Mercury goes direct before deciding if this is something you want to pursue further.

In general, maintain a slower, more cautious pace in daily affairs during a retrograde period. Mercury is retracing some of its footsteps and this is a good time for us to do that same thing. Always include at least two days before (to slow down) Mercury goes retrograde and two days after (to resume regular activities) Mercury goes direct. This is called Mercury in Station and means that things are not quite back up to regular speed yet.

Lunar eclipses in your chart

April 15, 2014 – 10th house

You might have some strong emotions about your career or reputation at this time. Check matters through thoroughly before acting or reacting.

Oct. 8, 2014 – 4th house

Put some extra attention on your surroundings so that they are comfy, cozy and nurturing, similar to the feeling of being with your best friend.

Solar eclipses in your chart

Oct. 23, 2014 – 11^h house

Surround yourself with friends who are very important, who are supportive. Also, there is a focus on your hopes and dreams, with perhaps a new way to move forward on them.

Blue Moon (second Full Moon in a calendar month)

A Blue Moon amplifies the energies that would come with a regular Full Moon in an area of your life.

Black Moon (second New Moon in a calendar month)

A Black Moon intensifies the need to direct energies inward and to set aside time for introspection. It is similar to a New Moon but with more emphasis.

Jan. 30, 2014 – 2nd house

Money is right at the forefront of things and something about it is strongly emphasized.

Mar. 30, 2014 – 4th house

Refresh your home or property in some way.

There will be no Blue Moon during the timeframe of your reading. The notation is just for your information. You may like to stay tuned to www.moonscopes.com for dates when these come up in the future.

Full Moon – emotions can become magnified in the denoted area of your life starting around one week before the Full Moon date.

January 16, 7th house – marriage, committed love partnership

February 14, 8th house – other people's money/resources, your sex life
This Full Moon is conjunct your natal Moon – emotions could run a little high re: love or finances

March 16, 9th house – higher education, travel, beliefs, other cultures

April 15, 10th house – career (paid or unpaid), reputation/place in the community

May 14, 11th house – friends, groups, goals, ideals

June 13, 12th house – spirituality, imagination

July 12, 1st house – self-development, social personality, physical self/appearance

August 10, 2nd house – earned money, possessions, values
This Full Moon is conjunct (right on top of) your natal Sun – your ego could be feeling a little down, fragile, or bruised re: money

September 9, 3rd house – communication, neighbors, siblings, education

October 8, 4th house – home, family, real estate

November 6, 5th house – children, creativity, fun

December 6, 6th house – health, daily routine or environment

New Moon – rest, refresh, & regenerate yourself and get ready to start anew in the listed area of your life.

January 1, 1st house – self-development, social personality, physical self/appearance

January 30, 2nd house – earned money, possessions, values
This New Moon is conjunct your natal Sun – pat yourself on the back for all that you contribute to life with the example of your values

February – no New Moon

March 1, 3rd house – communication, neighbors, siblings, education

March 30, 4th house – home, family, real estate

April 29, 5th house – children, creativity, fun

May 28, 6th house – health, daily routine or environment

June 27, 7th house – marriage, committed love partnership

July 26, 8th house – other people's money/resources, your sex life
This New Moon is conjunct your natal Moon – breathe some new life into your love life or finances

August 25, 9th house – higher education, travel, beliefs, other cultures

September 24, 10th house – career (paid or unpaid), reputation/place in the community

October 23, 11th house – friends, groups, goals, ideals

November 22, 12th house – spirituality, imagination

December 22, 1st house – self-development, social personality, physical self/appearance

Basic Astrology Terms

Chart - a map of the positions of planets and other astronomical configurations based on a person's birth data (date, place, time)

Planet - any of the major bodies in our solar system that appear to be orbiting in a relationship to each other. In addition to the Earth, the currently known planets are: Sun, Moon, Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto. (though technically the Sun and Moon are not planets but luminaries, they are referred to as planets for astrological purposes)

Sign - Aries, Taurus, Gemini, Cancer, Leo, Virgo, Libra, Scorpio, Sagittarius, Capricorn, Aquarius, Pisces - zodiac names that originated from constellations

House - any one of the 12 sections of an astrology chart

Rising Sign - a mathematical point also referred to as ascendant - the sign and specific degree of that sign, calculated from the birth information, that was on the eastern horizon at the exact moment of a person's birth

Asteroid - small astronomical bodies of matter, sometimes included in chart readings

Rulership - association between planet or sign and keywords or phrases

Aspect - the interaction, connection or relationship of planets to each other

Reading - interpretation of a chart by an astrologer

Transit - the pattern of movement of the planets through a birth chart

Horoscope - outlook, forecast, or prediction about what is coming up

Planetary aspects include:

- conjunct - right next to or very close to each other
- sextile - 60 degrees separation
- square - 90 degrees apart (at right angles to each other)
- trine - 120 degrees from each other
- opposition - 180 degrees apart, which means directly across the chart from each other.

Sextile and trine aspects are usually considered to be easy; a square is usually seen as challenging; an opposition is sometimes challenging; and a conjunction depends on what planets are involved.

Suggested Resources for Transit Readings

Planets in Transit by Robert Hand

This book contains fairly in-depth interpretations of planets as they travel through (transit) houses in a chart as well as in-depth information about the connections (aspects) they make to birth (natal) planets. Very recommended.

Astrology for the Light Side of the Future by Kim Rogers-Gallagher

The author uses a fun approach and contemporary examples in her descriptions of each planet's transits through the houses in an astrology chart and then also for the aspects of transiting planets to natal planets.

I will gladly recommend astrology books on any subject, providing they are available, if or when you are interested. And, in order to come up with the best chart interpretation on your own, you might want to check out what more than one book has to say.

When you read about the planet transits in your chart, remember to put as many of the pieces together as you can, just like you would in a puzzle, so that you will get a more complete picture. It may be good to review the basics about the planets, signs, and houses as you prepare to read about the transits in your chart. I can recommend a couple of books if you'd like.

As you assemble an interpretation of the transits, remember to select exactly what information, based on your personal experience, seems to be the most applicable. You may decide that you prefer some of the transit interpretations that you find in books to what is found in this reading, and that's fine. Go with what works for you.
